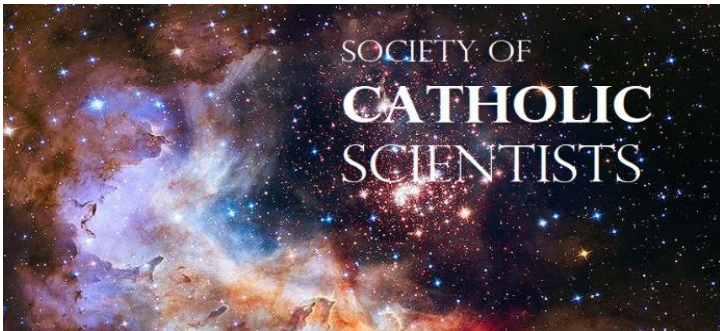
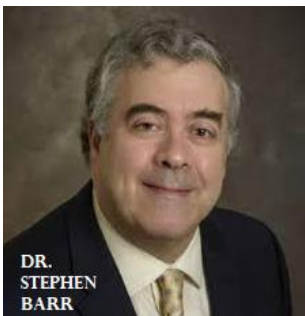


Faith & Reason

Has Science Discovered God? (Part 3 of 3)

Their mission is “To foster fellowship among Catholic scientists and to witness to the harmony of faith and reason to other scientists and be of service to those who are attempting to integrate the worlds of science and religion in their own intellectual and spiritual lives.” As of April 2019, there are now over 1000 scientists as members.

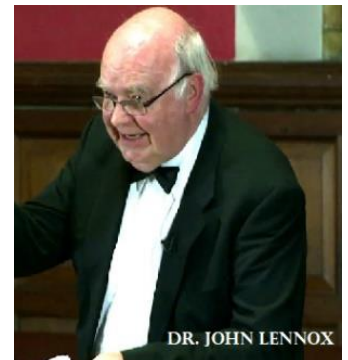


Stephen M. Barr PhD: President of the Society of Catholic Scientists; Professor of Physics and Astronomy of the University of Delaware and Director of the Bartol Research Institute. He received his PhD from Princeton University. He was elected a Fellow of the American Physical Society in 2011. He is the author of “*Modern Physics and Ancient Faith*” and “*The Believing Scientist: Essays on Science and Religion*.”

In 2001, scientists from around the world collectively wrote a document called “*A scientific dissent from Darwinism*.” They wrote, “we are skeptical of claims for the ability of random mutation and natural selection to account for the complexity of Life. Careful examination

of the evidence for the Darwinian Theory should be encouraged.” Scientists who are eligible to sign this statement include leading biologists, geneticists, quantum chemists & physicists, who must either hold a Ph.D. in a scientific field such as biology, chemistry, mathematics, engineering, computer science: Or, they must hold an M.D. and serve as a professor of medicine. There are over 1000 scientists who have become signatories of this scientific dissent.

Dr. John Lennox is a Professor of Mathematics at Oxford University, he says: “The beauty of the scientific laws reinforces my faith in an intelligent divine creator. The more I understand science, the more my faith in God is confirmed, because of my wonder at the breadth and sophistication of His design.” Dr. John Lennox sums it up, “Look at the Nobel prize winners, the idea that there is an essential conflict between science and religion is demonstrably false...The real conflict is between atheism and theism.”



Dr. Peter Kreeft, professor of Philosophy, Boston College, has written over one hundred books and co-authored “*Twenty Arguments for the Existence for God*.” He says it best, “the conclusion that God exists does not require faith, atheism requires faith. It takes faith to believe in everything coming from nothing. It takes only reason to believe in everything coming from God.”
